



The Swedish Bioinformatics Advisory Program 2017

The SciLifeLab bioinformatics platform (NBIS) offers a track where PhD students from any Swedish institute can get a senior bioinformatician as a personal advisor for up to two years of their PhD studies.

High-throughput technologies are transforming the demands on scientists in genomics and other medical and biological research fields. As many research groups are in need of large-scale data analyses, we see a need to complement the traditional role of the supervisors with bioinformatics consulting directed towards PhD students.

The program is free of charge.

Program outline:

- One start-up meeting, where the advisor visits the research group.
- One mandatory meeting per month, where the PhD student, supervisor and advisor meet in person or over video.
- Two grand meetings (1-2 days) per year for all PhD students, supervisors and advisors in the program.
