One hundred years ago the world's first Yoik concert was held here in Umeå

It was the Yoik-collector Karl Tirén who advertised for Sami artists to perform at a concert that was being held in Umeå as part of the musical arrangement. That was a great move. Three yoikers arrived from Malå and together with Maria Persson from Arvidsjaur they put on an outstanding performance. They drew endless applause for their musical performances.

This year we will commemorate the 100^{th} anniversary of the original concert with two days of festivities and music – Come and join us...

The celebration will begin with a Yoik precession with several Yoikers leaving from Rådhustorget at noon. They will work their way over to Mimerskolan (Vasaplan) where the original concert was held back in 1910.
