Exchange Studies

Niklas Andersson explained the basics around exploring opportunities for exchange studies, answering questions such as; Where can I go? Who can go? When can I go? Answering the question "Where can I go?", Niklas listed a number of countries and schools with special agreements previously signed with UID. The students able to go on exchange are BFA and MFA students with at least 60 ECTS credits. BFA students are able to on an exchange during their 5th semester and MFA students have the same opportunity in their 3rd semester. Niklas Andersson also announced that there will be a Wednesday Lecture on exchange studies on November 16, 2022. The deadline for exchange applications is February 1, 2023.

Taking care of each other

Niklas Andersson gave an update on the situation regarding Covid-19 as certain recommendations were presented on how students and staff can help reduce the risk of infection. Students were asked to wash their hands regularly and to use hand sanitizer when possible. The general rule is if you feel any symptoms, you are required to stay at home.

He also talked about how we can save energy at school, for environmental purposes and also tied to the global energy crisis. The key tip was to make sure that you turn off the lights in a room if you're the last one to leave.

Accident/Health insurance

An account was given by David Risberg and Niklas Andersson of the accident- and health insurances that apply for students belonging to different categories.

For EU students

- Health insurance at all times, but you need the "blue card".
- Accident insurance during school hours only.

Private accident insurance to cover your free time is up to you.

For exchange students

- Health insurance at all times.
- Accident insurance at all times.

We've got you covered.

For non-EU students

- Health insurance for study-related accidents only.
- Accident insurance during school hours only.

You **need** to get your own health insurance to cover accidents in your spare time or illness. Accident insurance for your spare time is up to you.

Personal injury insurance for ALL students

- Covers personal injuries through accidents and some cases of illness due to infection.
- Provides coverage during 'school time' = all the time
- a student spends on the University's premises (applies to study related activities only not pubs or parties :-)
- Applies if the student studies in the University's premises
- in the evenings.
- Applies when on the way to or from the University.
- Applies when at a workplace approved by the University (during internship courses).
 However, the insurance only applies in Sweden.
