Fire Safety

Fire Safety Officer Patrik Mattsson showed a film giving detailed instructions on how to handle a number of different scenarios relating to fire safety. Patrik also showed the evacuation plan that can be found around the school and recommended students to study them in case of emergency. One key detail that was particularly stressed was the assembly area in case of emergency, which is by Östra Strandgatan in front of Curiosum. Anders Hellström informed on another key point, namely the procedure of opening emergency doors at UID, as students were asked to not break the seal on the emergency doors. Detailed instructions on how to open them can be found on each emergency door.

Taking care of each other

Demian Horst gave an update on the situation regarding Covid-19 as certain recommendations were presented on how students and staff can help reduce the risk of infection. Students were asked to wash their hands regularly and to use hand sanitizer when possible. The general rule is if you feel any symptoms, you are required to stay at home.

He also talked about how we can save energy at school, for environmental purposes and also because of the energy crisis relating to the war in Ukraine. The key tip was to make sure that you turn off the lights in a room if you're the last one to leave.

Finally, an account was given on the rules and regulations that apply for arranging student pubs. Demian Horst reminded of the various potentially problematic situations that could result from the use of alcohol. A space was opened up for students to discuss how the well-being of all pub-goers could be better looked after and respected. It was also discussed how matters of harassment can and should be dealt with as the school's zero tolerance policy was reiterated.

Ställverket

Mika Sinclair, head of the UID student organisation Ställverket, presented the organisation and what it does, including that it's a sub division to the student union NTK. Ställverket communicates its ongoing activities on Teams. All students were encouraged to join the space on Teams in order to stay informed on Ställverket activities and the upcoming Ställverket election. Mika Sinclair also urged fellow students to join the UID student group on Whatsapp.

Mika Sinclair gave an account on the procedures for cleaning the student kitchen. A new formal document has been produced giving detailed instructions on what is expected from people using the student kitchen.
