Examples of aspects that were appreciated during the course

- The design of the home exam, well suited for the amount of time available to write it.
- The lecturers were considerate, positive and student-centred.
- Sometimes the theories were highly interlinked, clarification was always provided.
- The teachers approach.
- The home exam, the literature seminar and exposure to different articles.
- The course book was easy to understand.

Examples of aspects that could be improved in the course

- Lectures more interactive, not teachers reading from the slides.
- Talking more about how you decide what theory to use including more examples of how theories have been integrated in research and practice.
- Include practical sessions related to the theories.
- Intense schedule, lectures being too long and with too much content at a time.
- Scientific papers directly discussing the theories and their application should be provided.

Additional comments/recommendations

- The teachers made the lectures more understandable.
- Generally it worth the time, it was very informative and practical
- More practical sessions will be helpful to conceptualize the theories.
