## **General updates**

Head of Institute, Demian Horst, gave an update on the Brita-Stina Nordenstedt Scholarship applications. A record 18 applications were submitted by students from UID. The results will be announced in January.

Oscar Björk informed that costs are now covered for study-related printing. Students were asked to select their class account when printing (for example: 5310AFD, 5310BFA1, etc.). The misuse or printing of private materials may result in additional costs. Students were reminded that their cooperation will help UID staff maintain a sustainable and efficient work environment around printing. The new workshop teaching assistants hired by the school presented themselves to the participants at the meeting. The architectural proposal for the new student kitchen was unveiled. The new design includes a social space, a kitchen island, stainless steel appliances and added space for storage. Personalised utensils will be introduced shortly.

Demian Horst informed about the upcoming holiday period (23/12 - 7/1). There will be normal access to the UID premises. However, the workshops will be closed and the cleaning support will be reduced.
