

Exchange courses

Mandatory document when applying to be nominated for exchange studies through UMA's agreements

Instructions for how to list your courses:

- With your application, you are to submit a document where you list the courses you intend to study at each partner university you have applied to be nominated to. List a minimum of four courses per partner university, or example courses corresponding to 30 ECTS.
- The courses you list should only be examples of courses that you may take and that can be accredited after your exchange.
- Make sure the courses you select are at the correct study level and taught in a language you know and can study in.
- If the course catalogue for the upcoming academic year is not available, you may include example courses from previous years.

Note that

- The course selections are preliminary. If you are offered an exchange place, you may make new course choices in a later application to the partner university.
- Courses may have limited seats, and nominated students are not guaranteed admission to the partner university or to specific courses within the exchange programme.
- Only the written text will be evaluated; visual aspects will not be considered.

Upload the file in Solemove

- Save the file with your **name and “Exchange Courses”**, for example:
“Sofia Mikaelsson Exchange Courses”
- Upload the file in Solemove with your application in the **“Enclosures”** tab.
