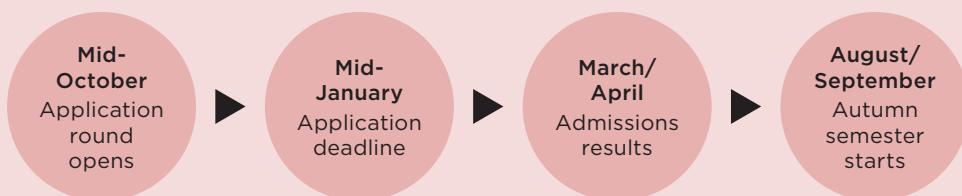

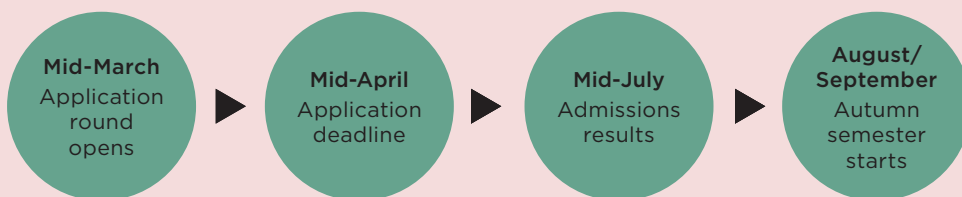
Important dates

A Bachelor's degree of at least 180 ECTS (equivalent to a Swedish kandidatexamen) from an internationally recognised university, and proof of English proficiency.

Specific entry requirements

Many Master's programmes also have further requirements, for example, a Bachelor's degree in a specific field of study or courses in certain subject areas. The entry requirements are specified on the programme's webpage.

Specific entry requirements

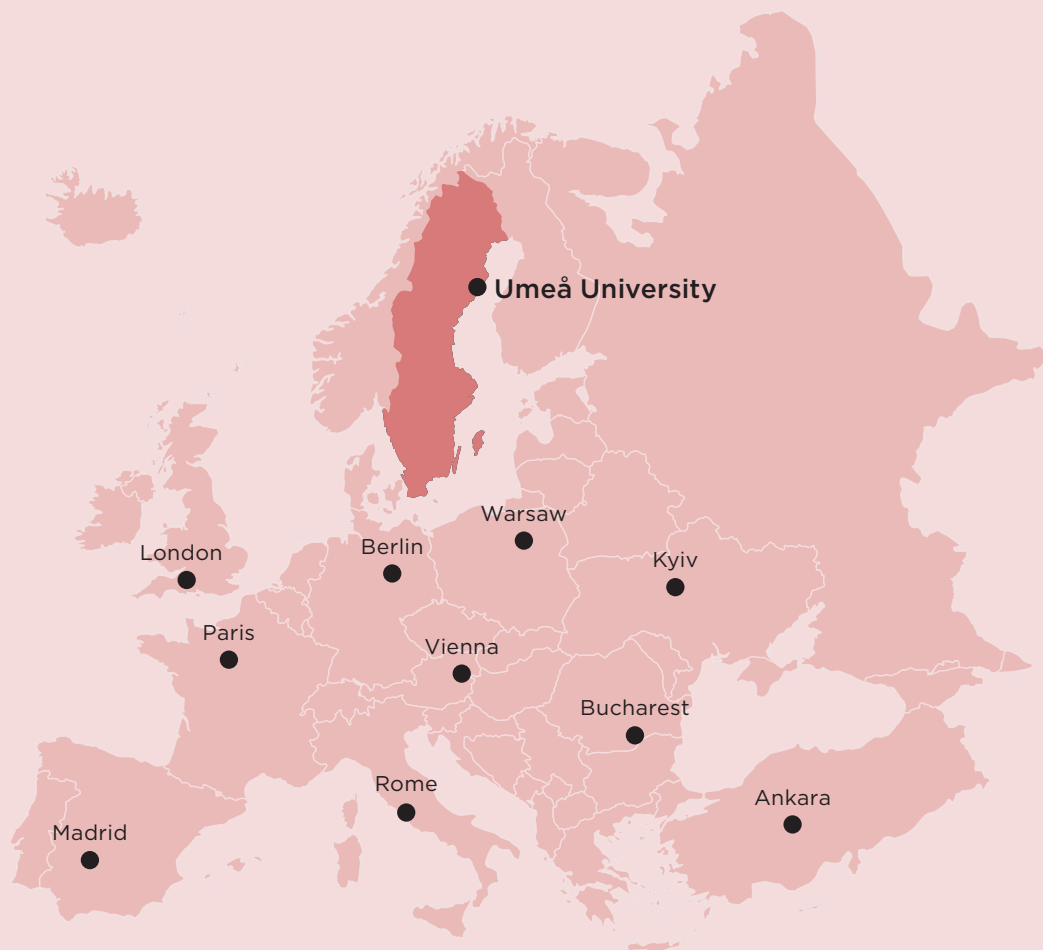
Most Bachelor's programmes have specific entry requirements often related to the field of study. The entry requirements are specified on the programme's webpage.

Local Travel	SEK 650
Phone/internet	SEK 400
Hobby/Leisure/Miscellaneous	SEK 1,990
Estimated monthly budget	SEK 10,656*

**Please note that this is an average monthly budget for living in Sweden as a student. The cost of living is generally slightly lower in Umeå. For example a single room in Umeå costs around SEK 4,600 per month.*
